**Call Box System Now Working** — You can now allow your visitors and vendors to enter our vehicle gates using the *Call Box* feature and your primary phone number. Read below to see how it works.



- 1. Visitor arrives at call box and uses the "A" or "Z" button to locate resident's last name.
- 2. Visitor presses the "call" button. System automatically dials resident's phone number. (The primary number resident provided to the management company).
- 3. Resident will receive a call from 480-563-1877.
- 4. Resident can talk to visitor through call box and press "9" on their phone to open the gate.
- 5. Contact *Denny Batchik* at APM to update phone number.



Tesoro's Treasurer, David Wick, summarized the year end financials at the annual meeting. Our *utilities, landscaping, and maintenance* expenses were reduced from 2021, even as many repairs were made, (pool, hot tubs, exercise room, vehicle and pedestrian gates, landscape rock). Although these expenses and others were reduced, assessment increases were still necessary in July 2022 to bring Tesoro to break even at year end.
