Architectural Review Committee (ARC) - Welcome 2024! I would like to thank the ARC members Melinda Medina, Mary Wick, and Wayne Lubner for their time, guidance, and commitment to oversee members' renovation requests and maintain compliance with the Associations' CC&Rs, Rules and Policies.

Tesoro Entry Door Options – This past year the ARC developed and posted four acceptable fiberglass entry door options for residents to reference when replacing their unit entry door.

Building Paint Scheme Clarification – The ARC received questions regarding the current paint scheme document. After reviewing several balcony and patio doors, the committee added clarification and revised the document.

Architectural Review Form - The committee has been busy streamlining the process for owners' renovation requests. The current form is undergoing an upgrade to a new editable form and will soon be posted on the website. As a reminder, an *Architectural Review Form* is required to be submitted before the start of any renovation project is initiated. Landscape Committee – Let's acknowledge the committee members Barbara Lapene, Dick Bellock, David Hurley, and Mary Wick for their hard work and diligence to keep Tesoro looking beautiful. The



committee is busy with continual assessments of the plants, shrubs, trees, irrigation, and granite. The committee seeks ways to meet landscape needs with cost effective and environmentally friendly approaches.

Replacement Plants – The summer's record heat took its toll on the Tesoro landscape. Approximately 50 plants did not survive the exceptional weather conditions. Tesoro residents voiced their opinions to have these plants replaced and the board responded by approving \$4,200 to replace the plants. The landscape committee worked with Superior Landscape to complete the project which included the areas mostly between unit driveways. During the placement selection for the new plants, the committee acknowledged the challenge of the limited size of the driveways and larger vehicles in the community and made accommodations for these challenges. The committee is requesting that the community be mindful when

entering and exiting driveways. The day after the new plantings were complete there were reports of multiple plants that were destroyed between driveways. The plants, at a cost of \$50 each, were removed and there is no plan to replace them at this time. Your efforts to help maintain our precious landscape will be appreciated by all.
